Rain Barrel Policy

Any homeowner who wants to place a rain barrel on their property need not submit an application to the Architectural Control Committee (ACC). The Board of Directors will allow the placement of rain barrels provided they meet certain criteria. The criteria established by the Board of Directors is that the barrels must be of a color to compliment the color of the house and when placed in public view, placed in a location that is esthetically pleasing to the existing property/landscaping. A means of controlling mosquitoes and stagnant water must be applied.

The ACC in their sole discretion shall determine what is esthetically pleasing. The barrels cannot become a nuisance in any manner in accordance with the Declaration of Covenants, Conditions and Restrictions, Article IX, Section 9.2

The above policy was approved by the Board of Directors at the August 4, 2009 Board of Directors Meeting.
